More about the Volunteer for Change programme at DRH Lindersvold



With this 10-month programme, we join hands with activists worldwide to fight for sustainable development in some of the poorest parts of the world. We believe that this kind of direct action is needed more than ever. Therefore, we invite you to join a group of like-minded people to learn, develop skills and create positive change through solidarity work. At the same time, you have the opportunity to broaden your horizons with the work of Humana People to People that takes place around the world.

Period One

Training at DRH Lindersvold in Denmark, 3 months

The preparation period focuses on studying history, the underlying causes of poverty, its effects on people and project-oriented solutions. In between studies you also carry out practical actions and conduct field investigations where you learn about social issues through conversations with people and experts.

Period Two

Project work in Malawi, Zambia, Mozambique or India, 6 months

In the six-month project period, you go to Zambia, Malawi, Mozambique or India – depending on the pandemic situation.

Here, you and your team are hosted by an NGO under the Humana People to People umbrella. You are connected to a long-term community project to do with Health, Education, Agriculture, Community Development or Environment.

As volunteers, you contribute to these sustainable development programmes in different ways, depending on what is needed and with the overarching aim of learning from the communities and their situation in the global reality, while you contribute to the project with your skills and experience.

Period Three

Conclusion and information work back in Europe, 1 month

After the project period, you will arrive back to DRH Lindersvold for one month to conclude and prepare presentations and information materials from your experience and present them to people around Europe.

Teams start four times per year.
